

HOW TO ORDER TREATMENT FOR LATENT TUBERCULOSIS INFECTION (LTBI)

Send the completed *Tuberculin Skin Test Reporting Form* to Ottawa Public Health, Communicable Disease Program:

Allow 7 working days to process the order.

Included with your order:

- Medication fact sheet(s) for your patient and
- A Latent Tuberculosis *Infection (LTBI) Treatment Record* form.

Please return the *LTBI Treatment Record* form to OPH at the end of treatment with the outcome information completed. There is a detachable card at the bottom of the form which you can complete and give to your patient for their records.

All bottles of medication are sent to the physician who then distributes them to the patient. For patient safety purposes, and to monitor compliance, please dispense 1 bottle of LTBI medication (100 tablets) at a time.

If you use Accuro or Bio-test, they will automatically pick up your order. For all others, OPH will notify you when your order is ready.
