If you click on one bar, the subgroup in the other related graphs and numbers will be highlighted. To turn off the highlighting, deselect the bar. You can also right-click on graphs to view data tables.



\* All the outbreaks listed above reflect the outbreak definitions at the time they were declared open. From April 1st, 1 staff or resident case of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 is considered an outbreak in long-term care homes (LTCH), retirement homes (RH) and other healthcare institutions and declared facility wide. Since **May 10th**, 2 staff or patient cases of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 within a specified unit within a 14-day period where both cases could have reasonably acquired their infection in hospital is considered an outbreak in a public hospital.



## How do I move between pages?



Clicking on the page arrow allows you to navigate through the three different pages of the dashboard:

## How do I print the dashboard?

To print the dashboard, follow these instructions:

*Having trouble viewing the report? Try viewing the report in **full screen mode**.*

1. Click on **full screen mode** from the main dashboard page
2. Once open, right-click and select “Print” to print page 1 of the dashboard.
3. To print page 2 of the dashboard, navigate back to the **full screen mode** and select page two
