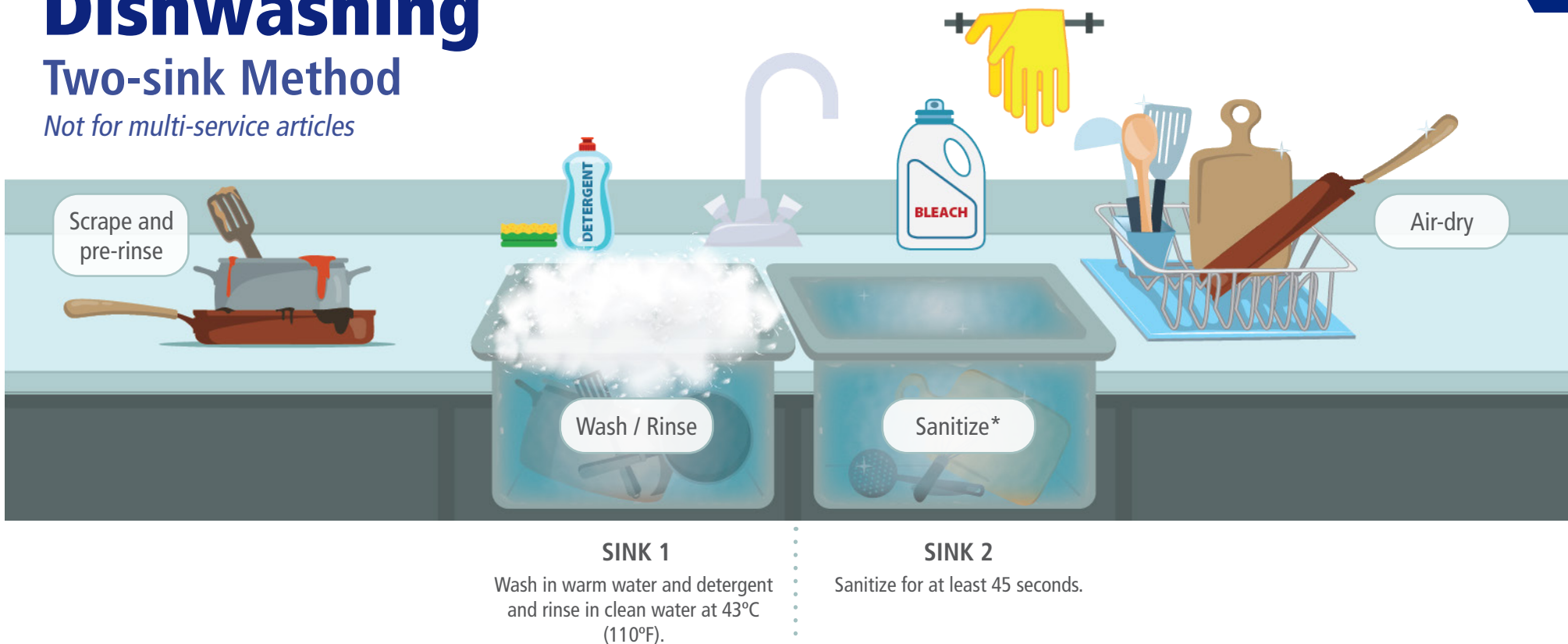


Dishwashing

Two-sink Method

Not for multi-service articles



*Sanitizer options

Use clean hot water of at least 77°C (170°F).

Mix clean water of at least 24°C (75°F) with chlorine (bleach) to make a mixture no weaker than 100 parts per million (ppm).

Mix clean water of at least 24°C (75°F) with quaternary ammonium to make a mixture no weaker than 200 ppm.

Mix clean water of at least 24°C (75°F) with iodine to make mixture no weaker than 25 ppm.

Other sanitizing products may be used if they are approved for use by Health Canada, the Canadian Food Inspection Agency or the medical officer of health for the intended purpose. Use sanitizers as written on manufacturer instructions and keep a testing kit onsite.
